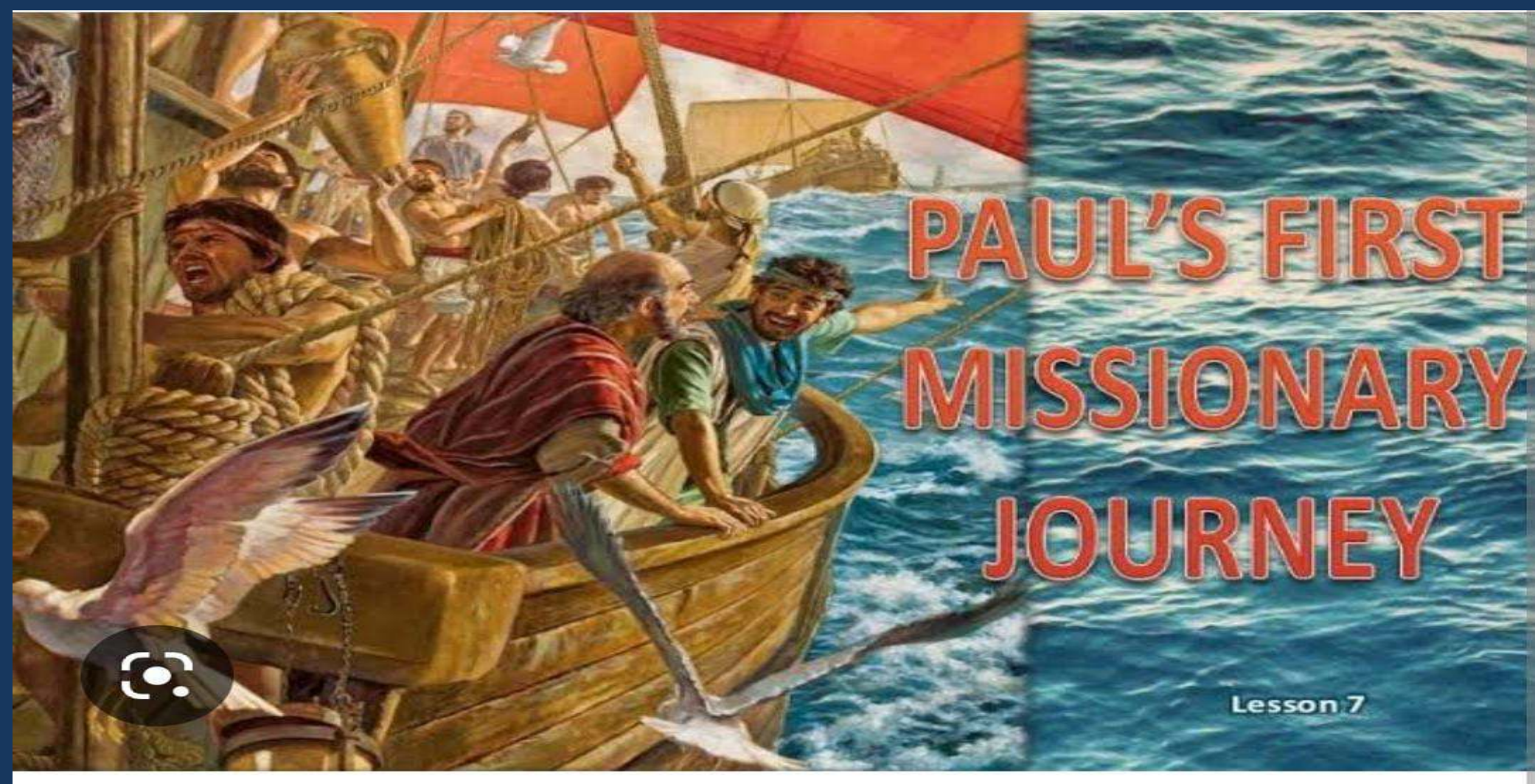

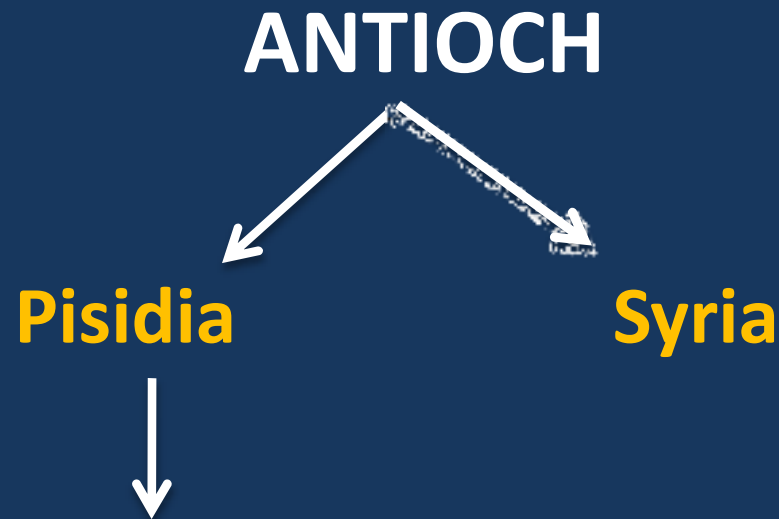

CHURCHES OF GALATIA



- In Antioch of Pisidia Paul preached Christ in the synagogue
- The Jews became envious of Paul and Barnabas
- Paul finally turned to the Gentiles as their Apostle.
- Paul and Barnabas expelled out of Pisidia

- The preaching of Paul divided the city
- They planned to kill Paul by stoning

LYSTRA

- Paul first recorded miracle of healing
- They named **Paul Mercurius** and **Barnabas Jupiter**
- Paul rejected sacrifice and preached Jesus to the people
- Jews came from **Antioch** and **Iconium**
- Paul was stoned to death
- They drew Paul's dead body to the city gate
- The believers gathered around his dead body and he came back to life
- The account in **2 Cor. 12 : 2**
- Those who believed congregated and became a church

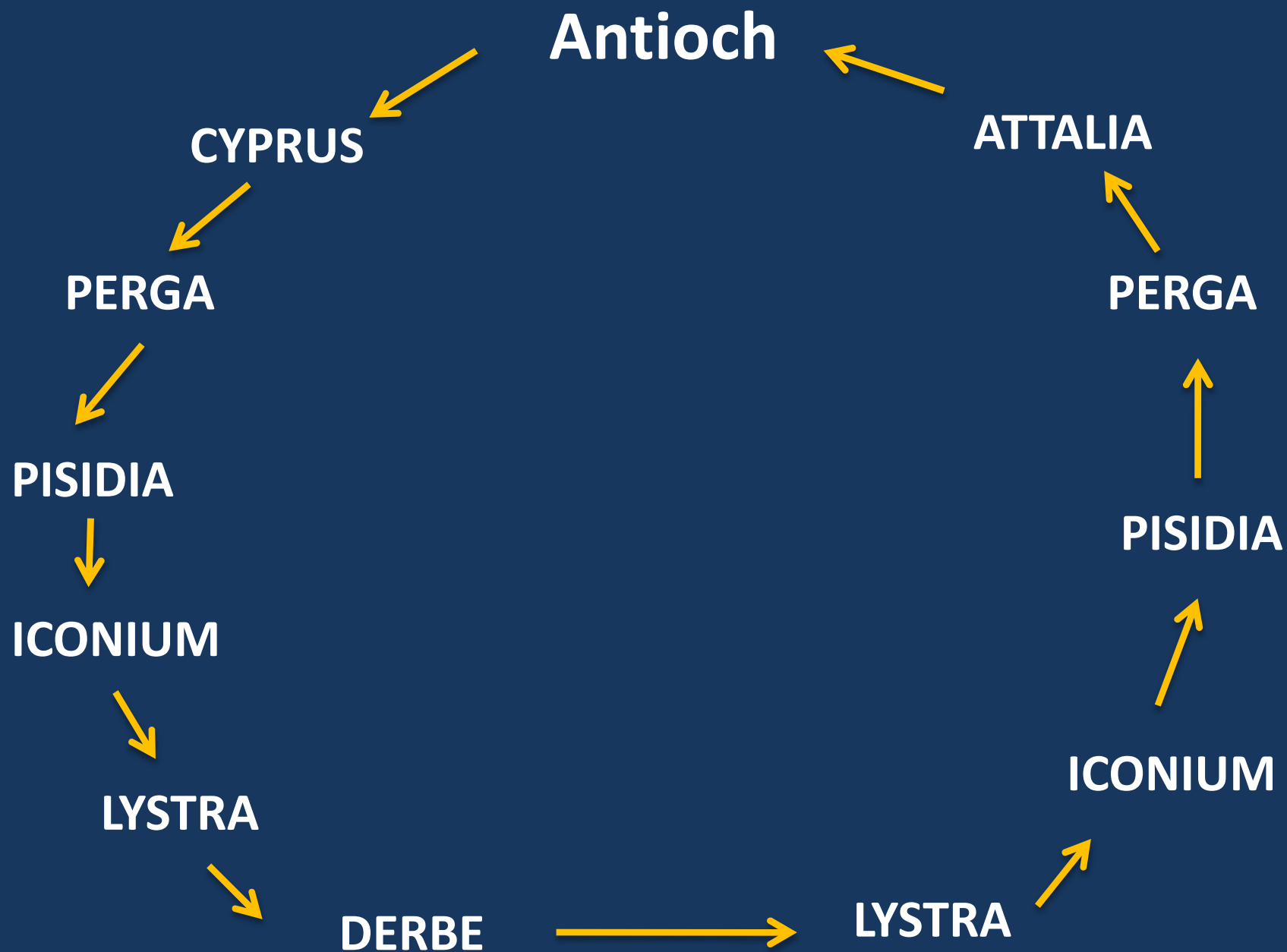

- Paul preached in the city of Derby
- We must through tribulation enter the Kingdom
- Ordained Elders in all the churches

THE PREACHING OF “ANOTHER GOSPEL”

- Judea believers accused Paul of not being in the **MESSAGE**
- They first accused Peter of not being in the **MESSAGE**
- They taught the Galatia brethren “another gospel”
- The Gentile Christians must first be circumcised
- They must observe the law of Moses before they can become a Christian and make heaven
- The Judea Christians said the Law is the Absolute

JUDEA CHRISTIANS

Vs

BRANHAMITES

- Paul is not in the message
- The Gentile Christians must be circumcised
- The law is absolute

Pst Moses Alu is not in the message

The church Must first believe that bro. Branham is the seventh messenger
