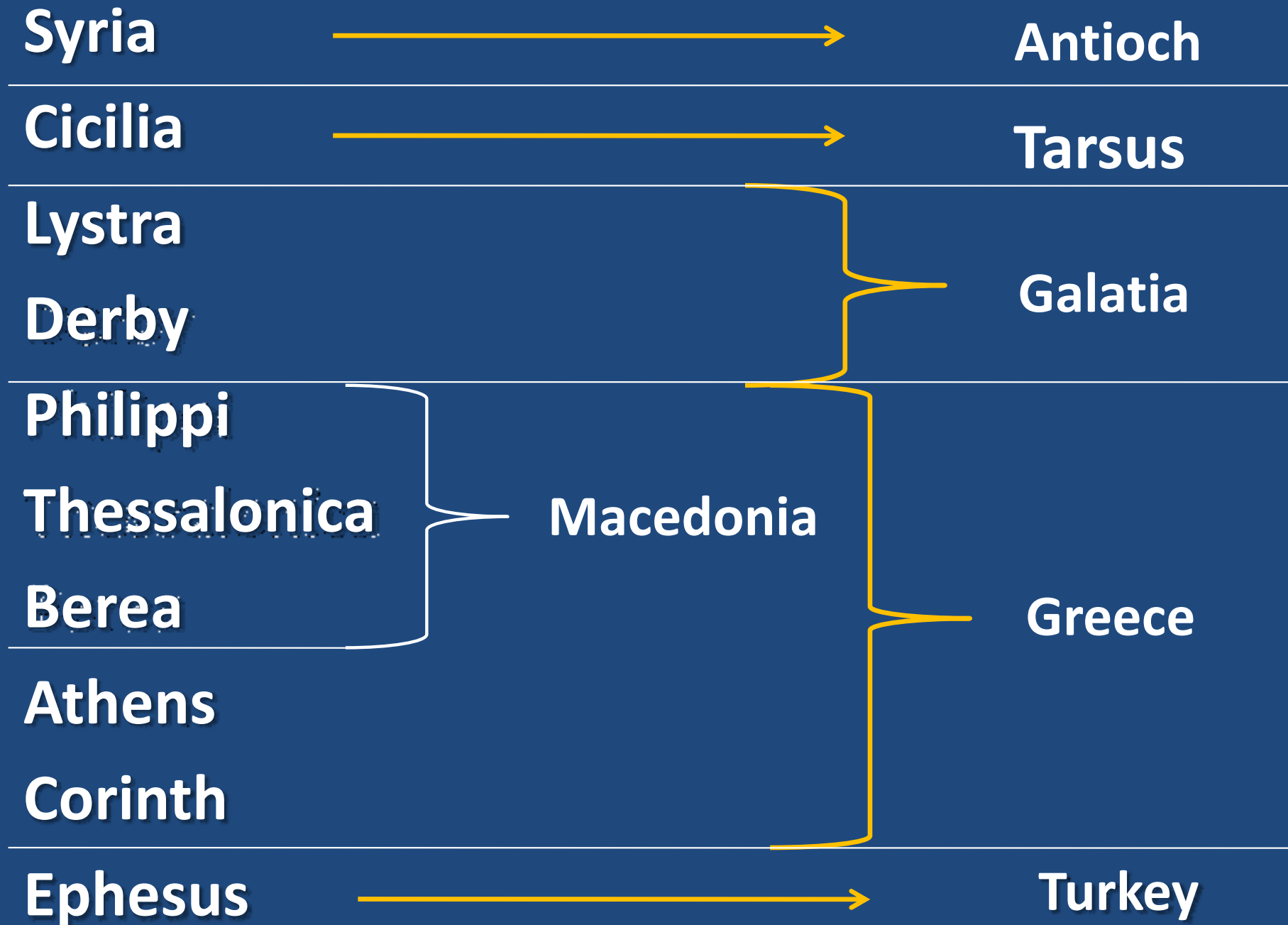

PAUL IN CORINTH

- Paul first preached in the Synagogue Acts 18:4
- Shortly before now, Emperor Claudius expelled Jews from Rome
Acts 18 : 2
- Aquila and Priscilla relocated from Rome to Corinth because of that decree **Acts 18:2**
- They had limited knowledge of further revelation **Acts 2:5-11**
- They believed that Christ the Messiah had come
- They knew that Christ fulfilled the prophecies of John the Baptist
- They have been Baptized in Jesus Name
- They have received the Holy Ghost
- They knew little of the significance of Christ's death and resurrection

PAUL IN CORINTH

- They knew little of the ministry of the indwelling of Holy Ghost
- They knew nothing about the mystery of the Church containing both Jews and Gentiles
- Paul, Aquila and Priscilla met and worked together as tent makers
Acts 18 : 3, 2 Cor 2 : 9, 1Thess 3:8
- For 18 Month, Paul expounded the gospel to Aquila and Priscilla while founding the Corinthian Church **Acts 18:11**
- Paul arrested in Corinth by the Jews Acts 18:12
- Those who believed congregated and became a Church
- Paul left Corinth to Ephesus with Aquila and Priscilla Acts 18:18

CORINTH



EPHESUS

PAUL IN EPHEBUS

- Paul first preached in the Synagogue **Acts 18 : 19**
- Paul Left Aquila and Priscilla in Ephesus and returned to Antioch **Acts 18 : 20 - 22**
- His return to Antioch ended his second missionary trip
- Aquila and Priscilla met Apollos who came from Alexandria
- Apollos only knew the Baptism of John
 - He believed that Christ the messiah had come
 - He knew that Christ fulfilled the prophecies of John the Baptist
 - He was certainly baptized by John
- Apollos didn't know the significance of Christ's death and resurrection
- He didn't know the ministry of the indwelling of Holy Ghost
- He didn't know the mystery of the Church containing both Jews and Gentiles

AQUILA, PRISCILLIA AND APOLLOS IN EPHESUS

- Apollos was teaching the baptism of John in the Synagogue **Acts 18:26**
- He was preaching repentance and faith in the Messiah
(The same thing John the Baptist preached)
- He had many disciples already in Ephesus with this incomplete gospel
Acts 19 : 1 - 3
- They expounded the word they learned from Paul to him **Acts 18:24-26**
- Apollos now armed with the complete message spoke to the Jews that Jesus was the Christ **Acts 18 : 28**
- Apollos armed with this further light moved to Corinth where he watered what Paul had sown. **Acts 19 : 1, 1 Cor. 3 : 6**
- Aquila and Priscilla wrote a letter to the Corinthian Church to recognize Apollos **Acts 18:27**
- Apollos became a minister in the Church of Corinth **Acts 18 : 27 - 28**

MINISTER APOLLOS IN CORINTHIAN CHURCH

NOTE:

- Apollos with his natural gift of preaching and evangelism attracted some loyal followers.
- Against his wish, the faction loyal to him created division among the brethren. **1 Cor. 1 : 11 – 12**
- The last mention of Apollos was in Crete Church where Titus was the pastor **Titus 3 : 13**
- Irrespective of the Corinthian differences Apollos was still a part of Paul's Ministry

- Partisanship **1 Cor. 1 : 10 - 13, 1 Cor. 3 : 4**
- Jealousy and Quarreling **1 Cor. 3 : 3**
- Incent relationship **1 Cor. 5 : 1 - 13**
- Prostitution **1 Cor 6 : 12 - 21**
- Food Sacrificed to Idols **chapter 8 and 10**
- The veiling of women **1 Cor. 11 : 1 - 16**
- The Lord's Super **1 Cor. 11 : 17 : 34**
- How to use Spiritual gifts **Chapter 12 - 14**

THE BOOK OF FIRST CORINTHIANS

There were three letters Paul wrote to the church of Corinth

- The missing Epistle to the church of Corinth **1 Cor. 5 : 9**
- First Corinthians
- Second Corinthians

He is now clarifying a statement he made in the missing letter to prevent misunderstanding **1 Cor. 5 : 10**

Note:

- Their response to the missing letter
- The complain from the household of Chloe **1 Cor. 1 : 11**
- The delegates sent by the church with a letter gave rise to the written of First Corinthians **1 Cor. 7 : 1, 1 Cor. 16:17**
